- 25% of Iowans reported excessively drinking as compared to 20% national in 2022 (State Rankings).
- Alcohol-involved deaths in Iowa have increased by more than 73% from 2008 - 2019 (U of I Public Health 2022).
- According to BreastCancer.org, (breastcancer.org)
 - One standard drink a week increases your risk of breast cancer, three or more weekly increases it by 15%.
 - Teen and tween girls aged 9-15 who drink three to five drinks a week have three times the risk of developing benign breast lumps, which are associated with higher risks of breast cancer later in life.

According to the Governor's Office of Drug Control Policy - in 2022, 69%, or 30,322 Iowa patients, visited emergency departments due to alcohol use alone, a 4.3% increase from 2016 (Iowa.gov).
